Attorney Verst presented **Ordinance No. 16-0901: An Ordinance Levying an Ad Valorem Tax Rate for the Year of 2016 on All Property Real (0.200 percent of each \$100 of assessed value) and Personal (0.337 percent of each \$100 of assessed value) in the City of Wilder, Ky, Setting the Waste Collection/Recycling Rate (\$150.00 per unit annually and \$135.00 annually for those properties receiving homestead exemption) for 2017 on Properties Receiving Curb Side Collection, Levying an Ad Valorem Tax Rate on Motor Vehicles (0.148 percent of each \$100 of assessed value) for 2016 in the City of Wilder, Ky, Establishing the Rates Therefore and Providing For A Tax Lien Against All Taxable Property in the City of Wilder, Kentucky to Secure the Payment of Said Taxes. 
Adjournment:
